

VASSE ESTATE COMMUNITY SPONSORSHIP GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

Vasse Estate values the important role community groups' play in establishing a community where residents feel welcome, connected and in which they can live happy, healthy lives.

These guidelines have been produced to assist local, not-for-profit community groups to apply for financial assistance from Vasse Estate through the sponsorship program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The Vasse Estate Community Sponsorship Program, intends to benefit the community residing in Vasse or the immediate surrounds. It is aimed at, but not limited to not-for-profit organisations, sporting clubs, schools and programs that focus on the following:

- Environment and sustainability
- Educational opportunities
- Sport, lifestyle and healthy choices
- Youth development
- The arts

The sponsorship program is generally not intended for:

- Individuals and personal activities
- Political campaigns/lobbying groups
- Groups, organisations and programs which do not comply with the values of Vasse Estate

APPLYING FOR SPONSORSHIP

Applicants are required to submit an application form. Applicants may include additional information relevant to the assessment for sponsorship.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application within 30 days from the date received.

Applications will be assessed on a rolling basis throughout the year until all sponsorship funds have been expended.

Applications that are successful, that are not time sensitive, received after all funds have been expended or that cannot be processed before the end of the financial year, will be held over to receive sponsorship in the next financial year.

Successful applicants will be required to enter into a sponsorship agreement with Vasse Estate.

The applicant will be required to provide an invoice for the sponsorship amount and payment will be made within 30 days from receiving the invoice.
