

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The following terms and conditions (**Terms**) apply to the Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021 (**Competition**).
- 1.2 Entrants warrant that by submitting an entry into the Competition, they have read, understood and agree to be bound by these Terms.
- 1.3 These Terms will be published on the Promoter's website and Facebook Group Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021.
- 1.4 Entrants are encouraged to 'add a listing' to the Christmas Light Search website for the purpose of creating a community map of Vasse Estate Christmas Light displays. This however is not a condition of Entry and is completely voluntary. In doing so entrants warrant that they have read, understood and agree to be bound by the terms as set out by Christmas Light Search (Red Reindeer Media) Website Policies (Version 4 - Updated: 21 November 2021)

2. Promoter

3. Duration

- 3.1 The Competition will commence at 9.00am (AWST) on, Monday 29 November 2021 and will end at 11.59pm (AWST) on Sunday, 19 December 2021 (**Competition Period**).

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 Only homes decorated with a Christmas lights display which are located within the Birchfields and Dawson Estates of the Vasse development area may be entered as part of this Competition.
- 4.2 Entry to the Competition is only open to residents of the Birchfields and Dawson Estates of the Vasse development area, who are:
 - (a) permanent residents of Western Australia; and
 - (b) over the age of 18 at the time that the prize is drawn.
- 4.3 The following persons are ineligible to participate in the Competition and may not redeem any prizes offered in the Competition:
 - (a) employees and the immediate families of the Promoter, its related bodies corporate, associated sponsors and the suppliers of prizes;
 - (b) a person who is discovered to have used or attempted to use more than one name in entering the Competition;
 - (c) a person who has submitted more than one entry;

- (d) a person whose entry is incomplete or incomprehensible or whose entry, in the opinion of the Promoter, includes any content which may be or is unlawful, profane, inflammatory, defamatory and/or damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Promoter; and
- (e) a person who breaches any of these Terms.

5. Method of Entry

- 5.1 To enter the Competition, eligible individuals will need to upload images, videos and display details of completed Christmas lights display on their home within Birchfields and Dawson Estates, to the Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021 Facebook Group.
- 5.2 The entry may consist of a maximum of 5 photos and 1 Video and must include Christmas display address.
- 5.3 Entries may also be must be submitted by email to community@vasse.com.au and a post will be created on their behalf during the Competition Period, together with the entrant's full name, address, email and telephone number.
- 5.4 Entrants must make their street address public in order to be included in Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021 competition.
- 5.5 Entries received after the Competition Period will be deemed invalid and will not be considered.
- 5.6 If an entrant's contact details change during the Competition Period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter.
- 5.7 The Promoter takes no responsibility for lost or misdirected entries.

6. Selection of Winners

- 6.1 A winner will be selected by the Promoter on Tuesday, 21 December 2021 by chance draw of the entries submitted during the competition period.
- 6.2 A Community Choice Prize will be selected by the total number of likes on the image of the Facebook post of the entrant in the Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021 Facebook Group.
- 6.3 The first eligible entrant will be selected with reference to the time and date of post to Vasse Estate Christmas Lights 2021 Facebook Group.
- 6.4 The Promoter's decision on the two winners is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

7. Prize Details

- 7.1 The winner of the draw prize will receive Vasse Village Gift Vouchers to the value of \$300 to be used at any participating retailer within Vasse Village.
- 7.2 The winner of the Community Choice prize will receive Vasse Village Gift Vouchers to the value of \$200 to be used at any participating retailer within Vasse Village.
- 7.3 The first eligible entry will receive Vasse Village Gift Vouchers to the value of \$50.
- 7.4 Vasse Village Gift Voucher are subject to the standard terms and conditions, see item 8.

7.5 The Promoter is not responsible or liable if for any reason beyond its reasonable control any element of any prize is not provided. The Promoter may, but is not obliged to, substitute a different prize of equivalent value in place of any prize offered.

8. Vasse Village Gift Voucher Terms and Conditions

8.1 Voucher winners must be over 16 years old and live in Western Australia.

9. Notification

All winners will be notified at the time of winning by any of the available methods, facebook direct message, email and or telephone.

10. Prize Collection

- (c) agree that if they are selected as one of the three winners of the Competition, the Promoter may use and publicise their names and their entries for any promotion or matter incidental to the Competition or to the Birchfields and Dawson Estates.

To the extent permitted by law, all entrants release the Promoter from, and indemnify the Promoter against, all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of acceptance of any prize(s) or participation in the Competition including (but not limited to) loss of income, loss of opportunity, personal injury and damage to property, whether direct or consequential, foreseeable, or due to some negligent act or omission or otherwise.
